

In addition to production in the United States, Standard Oil rapidly increased production of its overseas affiliates during World War II from 340.7m to 513.2m per annum bringing the company's aggregate production to 1.19m barrels of oil per day.

Standard Oil's production represented over 20% of US oil output by the end of the war.
