
Kill Ratios of Participating Japanese and US Troops at Eleven Battles in the Pacific War

The columns show kill ratios of participating Japanese and US soldiers at 11 island battles in the Pacific War



^{*}The Battle of Okinawa was the only battle of World War 11 in which the number of US casualties exceeded the number of enemy troops present

^{**}The number of US combatants killed at Okinawa was boosted by the 4,900 naval deaths primarily from Kamlkaze attacks

^{***} The lower kill ratio is probably due to the 20,000 Okinawan conscripts who were more likely to surrender than Japanese troops.
